CARE Nepal hereby invites applications from the interested candidates for **Project Manager** Position for the **CRADLE project**. This project is Community Responsive Antenatal, Delivery and Life Essential (CRADLE Support for Mothers and Newborns in Nepal) Project in the field of Maternal and Neonatal Health care. The CRADLE Support Project is for four years started from 1st October 2007 until 30 September 2011. The working areas are Doti and Kailali districts. The project aims for sustainable improvement in maternal & neonatal (MN) health in the districts of Doti and Kailali.

Responsibility: The Project Manager (PM) will be responsible to manage and guide implementation of project strategies. S/he will co-ordinate with regional and district level MoHP staffs and other stakeholders. S/he will supervise staff and work with local NGO partners.
